



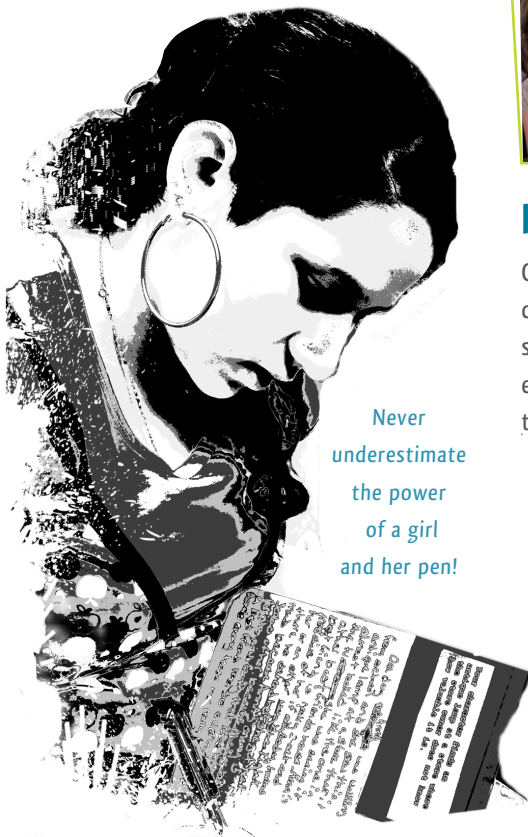

Workshops take place at inspiring locations throughout Los Angeles including MOCA, the Grammy Museum and the Los Angeles Times headquarters, just to name a few.

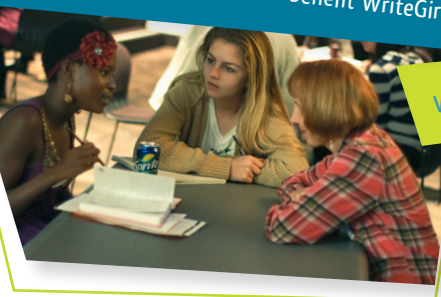
WriteGirl was honored by Michelle Obama with the National Arts & Humanities Youth Program Award

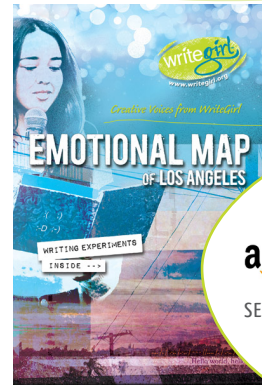

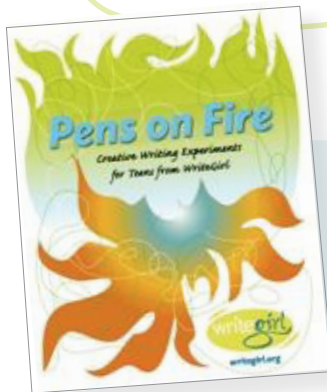
Buy WriteGirl Books
